

Corrigendum

In April 2015, a plant patent application (14/545,561) was filed with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) to name the USDA–ARS blueberry select ORUS 10-1 as 'Baby Blues'.

At the time of publication in June 2016, the authors were not aware of any potentially similar or confusing names. However, on 1 Sept. 2016, they were notified by the USPTO that they believed the name was too similar to a groundcover, ornamental blueberry being sold as 'Baby Blue'.

In response to their request, the authors reluctantly changed the name to '**Mini Blues**' and the patent application went forward under the same patent application number and was accepted by the USPTO and is patent pending.
